Registration for the IPPNO Conference and the Parliament:

The registration includes the 11th Session of the Provisional World Parliament and the International Philosophers for Peace Conference at this beautiful Sri Aurobindo ashram in the Utarakhand Himalayas.

The Registration fee also includes room, vegetarian meals, coffee breaks, materials, and organization for the full five days and six nights of the events. Participants will normally arrive on July 2st and leave on July 8. (Rooms may be reserved after the conference for couple of days for local hiking and sightseeing.) This is a real bargain by any measure. Delegates will only need to cover their own transportation costs to and from Nainital. International travelers may fly to Delhi on July 1st, stay overnight in the Sri Aurobindo guest house in Delhi (cost about rs 600), and take a train or bus for Nainital the following day.

Early Registration before April 1st, 2008 is \$350 US for hard currency countries (Japan, Europe, North Am.)

Early Registration before April. 1st 2008 is \$53 (2500 Indian Rupees) for those from non-hard currency countries.

Later Registration after April 1st, 2008 is \$400 for hard currency countries (Yen, Euros, Pounds, or Dollars).

Later Registration after April 1st, 2008 is 63 (3000 Indian Rupees) for non-hard currency countries.
